Em Rex — Emergency Exit Device

EMERGENCY REQUEST TO EXIT SWITCH

The Em Rex is an emergency door release unit, which is used in conjunction with the Prox Rex touch to exit unit to make up a total access control exit unit.

Used in an Access Control System to work in conjunction with an exit button to give emergency egress to comply with building codes;

FEATURES

- Has 3x N/C-N/O outputs I amp DC rated;
- Ist output to the Access Controller to log the operation of the unit;
- 2nd output to break lock power directly;
- 3rd output to activate a local audio sounder (if required);
- A red indication bar also shows when the unit has been activated.

MOUNTING

- Fits into a standard single flush box.
- Surface mounted with optional deep surround.
- Fits next to the Prox Rex on an optional special Double Flush Box (not standard) and double surround.
